



- 2. What do you understand by debeaking? Explain why it is an important practice in laying flock. (5 marks)
- 3. In poultry farming, if pullets have to be moved (transferred) from one house to another some rules have to be followed. What are those rules?

- **4. a**. During the brooding period, the artificial heat should be provided to chicks, why?
  - **b**. What happen when the temperature is too high in brooder?

- Differentiate mass selection from pedigree as the methods of breeds selection in poultry.
- **6.** You are hired in hatchery and you are given the responsibility of selecting eggs and setting them into the incubator.
  - a) In selecting eggs for incubation, give any six (6) causes for rejecting eggs.

  - b) While setting the eggs in the incubator, should the broad end be up or down? Explain. (2 marks)
- 7. Give the sources of heat in poultry farming shelter. (5 marks)

- 8. A farmer needs to eliminate excess newborn rabbits from a large litter by means of fostering. Identify the rules to respect when fostering them to a smaller litter.

- 9. What is coecotrophy? Give its role. (5 marks)
- 10. The White New Zealand is the most exploited rabbit breed in Rwanda.Outline its five (5) most important characteristics. (5 marks)
- 11. How is pig managed during Pregnancy? (5 marks)
- 12. Basing on physical characteristics, give the difference between landrace and large white pig.(5 marks)

- 13. What are steps involved in commercial hatchery operations? (10 marks)
- 14. A technician should be familiar with mating in rabbits.
  - a) Explain the mating in rabbits (management and frequency of mating for the buck, ratio and proper time of the day for mating).(7 marks)
  - b) Why is the mating always done in the buck's cage? (3 marks)
- 15. Describe Bio-chemical prevention measures taken for controlling pig diseases.(10 marks)
- 16. Iron Supplement is necessary for young piglet, describe the method of giving iron and the indications of iron in management of young piglet.
  (10 marks)
- 17. Cross breeding is crossing of two breeds which are genetically different or the ability to combine in one or more individual of desirable characteristics of two or more exiting breeds. By using an example, make a chart of absorption and rotational cross breeding in pig farming. (10 marks)
- **18.** Parasites are organisms which live on other living things (hosts) and obtain food and shelter from the host.
  - a) What are the major problems caused by worms to infested animals?
  - b) Give the general signs of worm infestation in pig. (10 marks)
